PHC-MoC promotes high-quality, people-centred primary care and essential public health functions as the core of integrated health services throughout the course of life

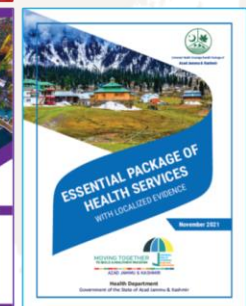
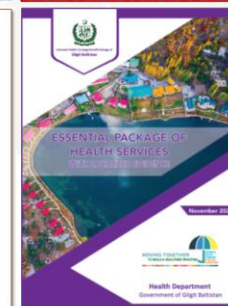
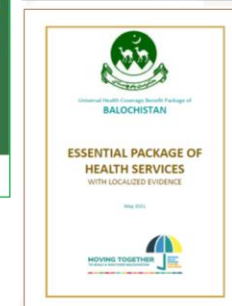
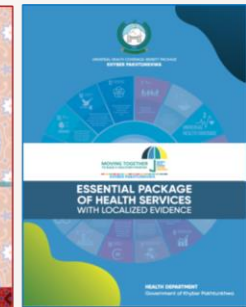
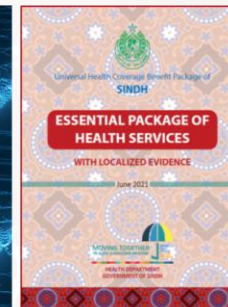
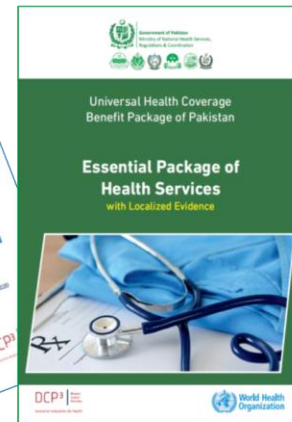
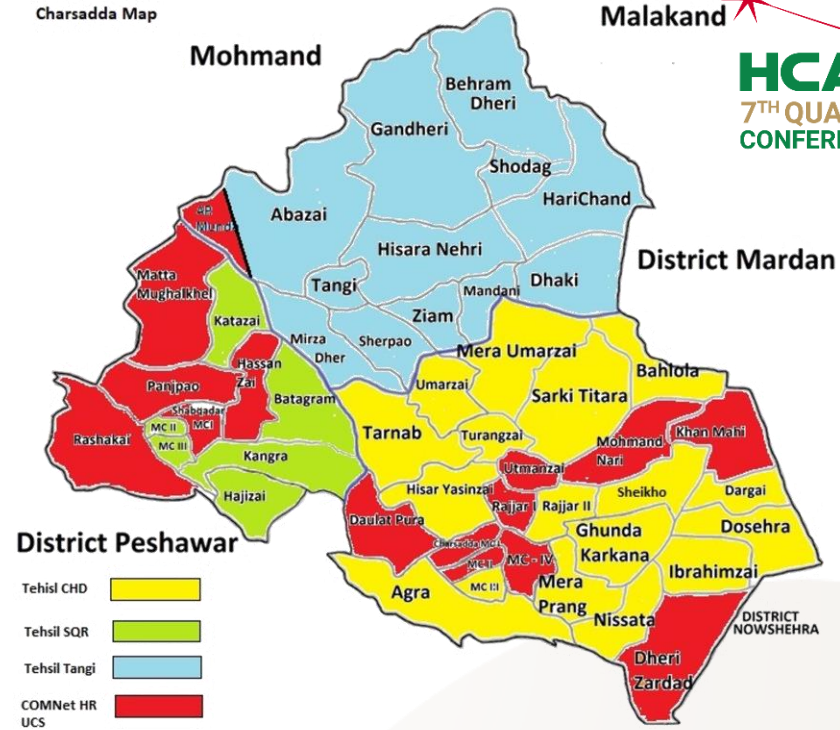
