Achieve Measurable Improvement in 6 Key Practices:



- Enhanced dietary diversity during pregnancy
- Immediate breastfeeding (BF)
- Exclusive BF through 6 months and continued BF through 2 years
- Timely introduction of appropriate complementary foods
- Use of modern contraceptive methods (MCM) postpartum





Figure 1: Social and Behavior Change within HSS






