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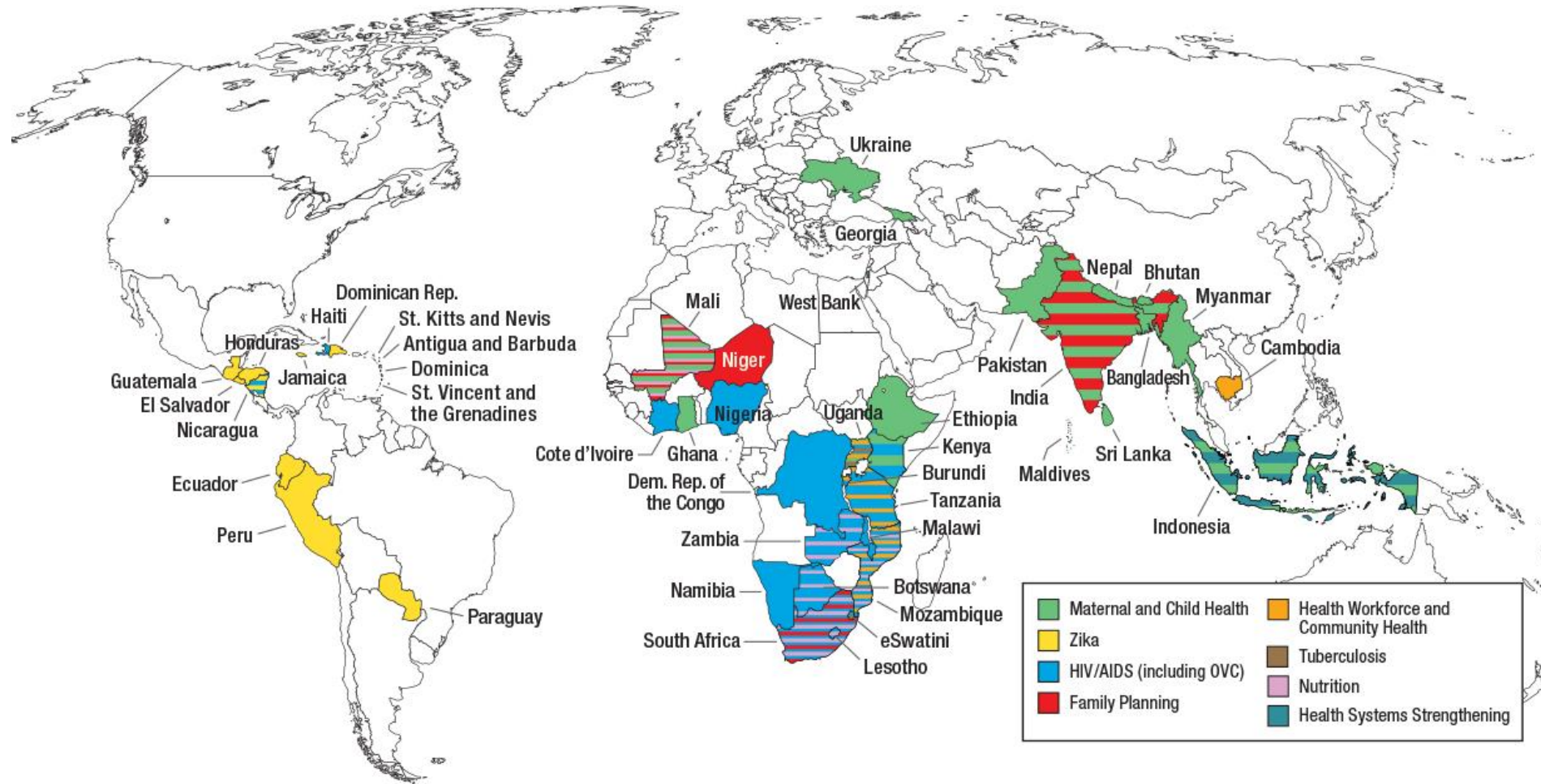

## What did we learn?

- We can improve healthcare, across socio-economic and cultural contexts, and across technical areas.
- We can scale up improved care, but there is still more to learn about scaling-up.

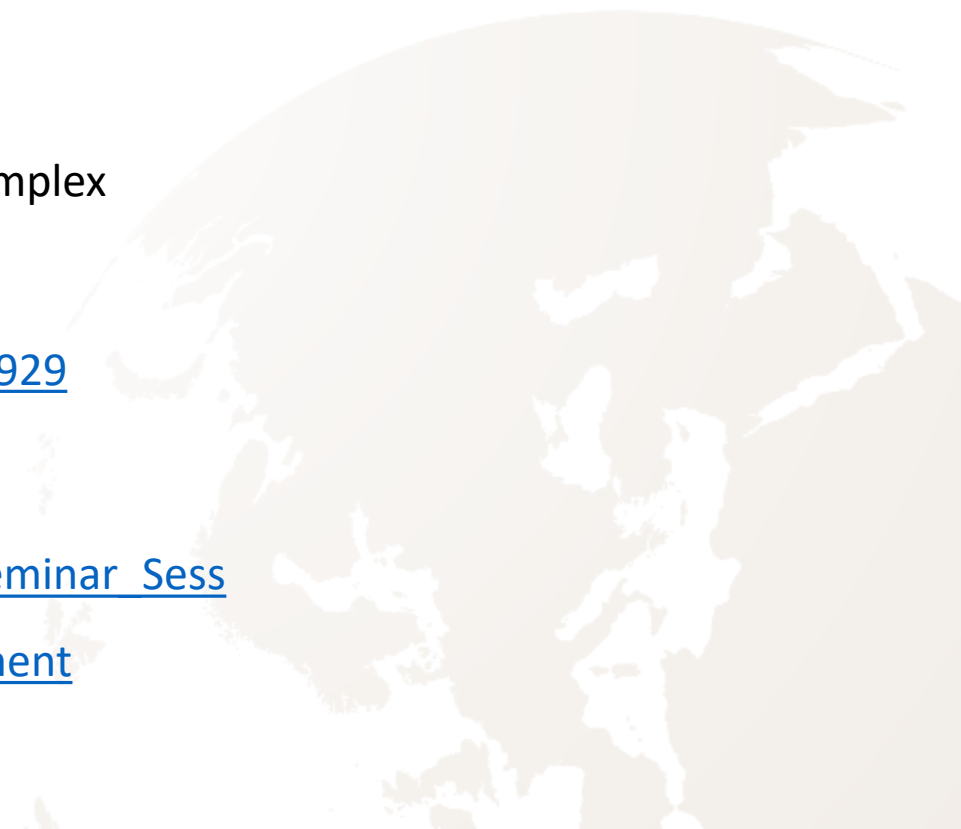

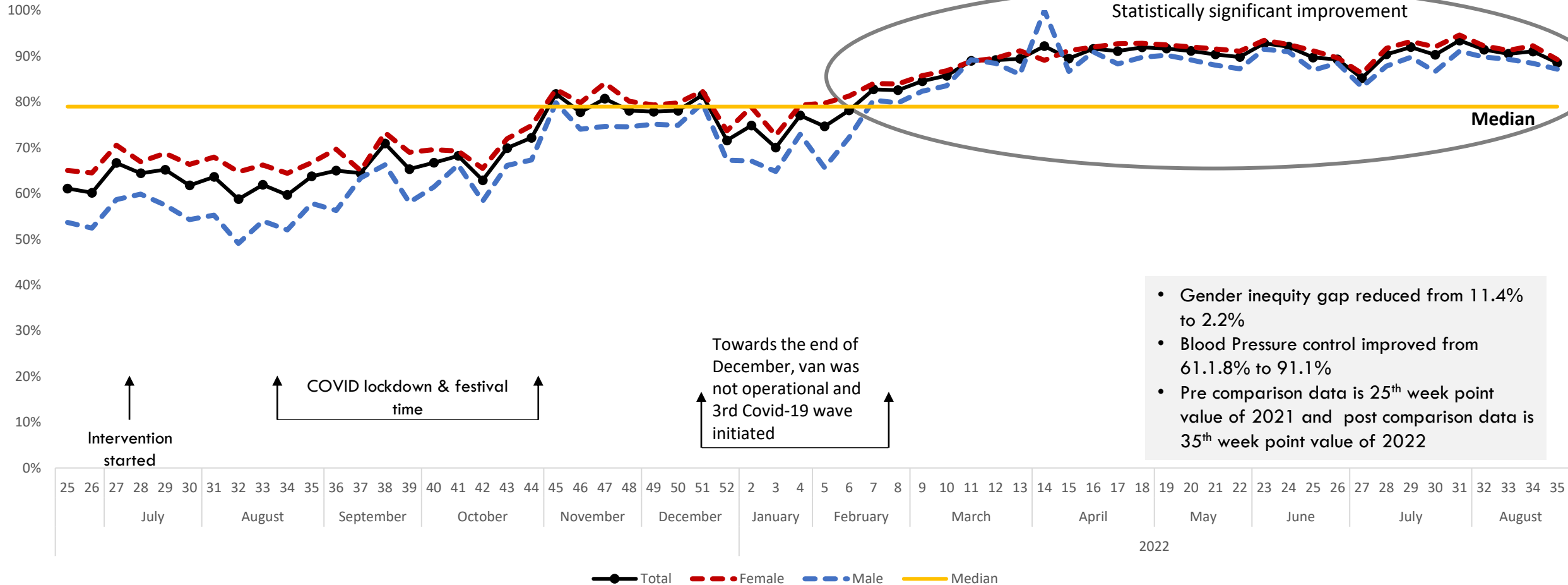

# Percent Hypertension Patients with Normal Blood Pressure - All Mobile Health Center

Percentage of hypertensive visits with controlled blood pressure



- Gender inequity gap reduced from 11.4% to 2.2%
- Blood Pressure control improved from 61.1.8% to 91.1%
- Pre comparison data is 25<sup>th</sup> week point value of 2021 and post comparison data is 35<sup>th</sup> week point value of 2022
